Dear Mr. Knifer:

Your facility's industrial wastewater discharge permit is renewed as attached for a five year term. The permit will expire on October 6, 2018, and the renewal application must be submitted to Inland Empire Utilities Agency by April 6, 2018. Please review the permit carefully as you are required to comply with its terms all times.

Please note that the Daily Average Flow Limit (DAFL) noted in Section 7 of the permit is based on the average flow discharged to the Non-Reclaimable Wastewater System (NRWS) determined during the review of your permit application. The DAFL does not impact the number of capacity units your facility holds and IEUA will enforce only the flow limit determined from those capacity units.

IEUA is also requiring your facility to report monthly wastewater flow discharged to the NRWS by the seventh calendar day following the end of each month. Please complete the electronic reporting form provided by IEUA and submit it electronically to ieuaflow@ieua.org. Please be aware that failure to submit the flow report by the required due date may result in enforcement action.

The attached documents constitute a joint permit for the above facility for industrial wastewater discharge to the Non-Reclaimable Wastewater System (NRWS) owned and operated by the Inland Empire Utilities Agency (IEUA) and the sewerage systems owned and operated by the County Sanitation Districts of Los Angeles County (Districts) per the conditions set forth in the attached documents. The joint permit is issued in accordance with the provisions of the IEUA's Ordinance (presently Ordinance No. 62 and any amendment thereof) and the Districts' Wastewater Ordinance (dated April 1, 1972, amended July 1, 1998, and any amendment thereof). Compliance with this permit does not relieve the above-named permittee of the obligations to comply with the provisions of the IEUA's Ordinance, the Districts' Wastewater Ordinance, IEUA and Districts policies and guidelines, and any applicable pretreatment regulations, standards, or requirements under local, California state, and Federal laws and regulations. Noncompliance with any term or condition of this permit shall constitute a violation of the above referenced Ordinances. As this is a joint permit between the Districts and IEUA, any reference to the Districts in the attached documents also means IEUA; any requirement to contact the Districts by telephone shall be interpreted as a requirement to also contact IEUA at 909-993-1645; and any requirement to notify the Districts in writing shall be interpreted as a requirement to also notify IEUA at P.O. Box 9020, Chino Hills, CA 91709, except that Self Monitoring Reports should be sent only to IEUA.
